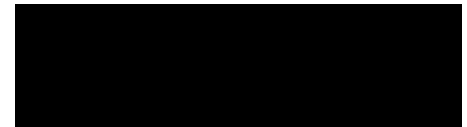

Supplementary Regulations

THE EVENT

A Rallycross is an event generally held on an unpaved, flat surface, on a short course consisting of straight sections and connecting turns and corners. This event conforms to section C of the CARS National Rally Regulations. Please see “Eligibility of Vehicles” and other preparation information below. This SnowX Event will take place at the Happy Valley Day Lot. Surface terrain will be hard packed snow and ice. More information about the rally weekend can be found in the Winter Rally supplementary weekend.

JURISDICTION

The rally will be held under the current rallycross regulations of the Canadian Association of Rallysport (CARS). This publication is available from CARS.

STATUS

Sanctioned by the Canadian Association of Rallysport (CARS) and Rally Pacific Motorsports (RPM). This event is part of The WCRA Rallycross Championship.

VENUE

DOCUMENTS

The following must be shown at registration and must be valid on the day of the event.

1. Provincial, or equivalent, driver's license for any crew member listed as driver.
2. Vehicle registration.
3. Third party liability insurance covering the entered vehicle.
4. When the owner of the vehicle is not entered as the driver or passenger, a written authorization from the owner of the vehicle
5. **Written permission from a parent or guardian for participation in the rally for persons under the age of 19 on the official form. Download in advance if parent(s) will not be present at the event. <http://www.carsrally.ca/CARSRally/Default.aspx?tabid=93>**
6. A minimum of a CARS Basic rally license for the driver in the rallycross. Residents of the USA who do not hold a CARS license may compete with a Rally America or NASA Rally license or better. See "Entry Fees" for more information about required memberships.

ELIGIBILITY OF VEHICLES

Vehicles

- a) Vehicles must be based on a production, closed body and chassis to compete. Ie: convertibles, open wheel cars, quads, etc are prohibited.
- b) All loose items in the vehicle must be removed during the event (including from the trunk).
- c) Snap-on hubcaps, detachable fender skirts and trim rings must be removed.
- d) Tires must be in good condition, with no cord or belts showing or cracks in the tread or sidewalls.
- e) Mechanical condition and safety of the vehicle is the responsibility of the competitor.
- f) Commercially available RENTAL CARS ARE NOT PERMITTED AT THIS EVENT. If you are driving a car that is not owned by you, you must submit a signed letter of permission from the registered owner, saying that they know that the car will be used in a rallycross competition and grant you permission to use their vehicle.

Ice racing tires (menards) and Snow Chains are not allowed for use at this event.

Mandatory Equipment

- a) Helmets conforming to NRR 1.A.6 or meeting Snell Memorial Foundation standards 1995M or 1995SA (or more recent) must be worn by all drivers and passengers. **DOT helmets will not be accepted.**
- b) Minimum three point seat harnesses must be worn by drivers and passengers.

VEHICLE CLASSES

Prepared 2WD + 4WD
- Studded, Gravel or Snow Rally Tires - Locked or Limited Slip Differentials - Weight Reducing Panels or Modifications - Engine and Drivetrain are Unlimited - Brakes and Suspension are Unlimited

Equipped 2WD + 4WD

- Studded, Gravel or Snow Rally Tires
- Interior Panels or Seats Removed
- Engine and Drivetrain are limited to the manufacturers product line and factory aspiration
- Brakes and Suspension are Unlimited

Production 2WD + 4WD

- Unstudded Snow Tires, All Season Tires
- Original Equipment must remain unless in the interest of safety
- Engine and Drivetrain must be unmodified
- Brakes and Suspension must remain in original configuration

Fuel Stops / Service

Please fill up on fuel before coming to the Resort. There are no fuel amenities at the venue.

ENTRIES

The maximum number of entries will be limited to **30 cars**. The organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry. Entries will be accepted until close of registration, and must include payment or it will not be accepted.

Competitors need to have a CARS Basic competition license, available at registration, or valid Regional/National Rally license. Residents of the US may compete on a Rally America or NASA Rally license. A one-day Basic License is available for \$10. Competitors who are not a member of an RPM affiliated club (WCRA, IRC, STSRA) will need to either purchase an annual membership or a one-day membership for \$10.

FEES

WCRA Club Membership: \$60 (download membership form off website)

One Day Club Membership \$10

RPM Basic License: \$25/year

Single-event RPM Basic License: \$10/event

Rallycross Entry Fee: \$50.00 CAD/USD

All cheques and money orders are payable to WCRA and must be current dated, or post-dated no later than December 2, 2011.
